200 yd. Relay 1 (12:00-1:30), Relay 2 (1:45-3:15).**

____ CF Iron Sight Offhand (20 Shot) & King (1 shot, last ½ hour of relay)

Sunday targets hung by 7:30

200 yd. Relay 1 (8:00-9:30), Relay 2 (9:45-11:15).**

____ CF Any Sight Benchrest (20 Shot)

200 yd. Relay 1 (11:30-1:00), Relay 2 (1:15-2:45).**

____ CF Any Sight Offhand (20 Shot) & King (1 shot, last ½ hour of relay)

Relays will be assigned when your registration is received and you may request 2nd relay, just let me know in advance. Entries will be limited to 36 shooters and will be reserved as the official entree forms are received. All Bench assignments will be assigned at check-in registration.

Firearm actions must be open and flagged when not on an active (hot) firing line! Flags will be available for purchase at the range. See Range Officer or ask at registration. Hearing and sight protection required.

Shooters will be responsible with marking their targets with their Name, Bench position, event type (exam. CF Iron Bench), caliber shot.

Shooters will score their own targets before turning them in. Targets will be turned in within 15 minutes of the end of relay. Each shot shall be recorded in the area designated for scoring on the target as well as a total.

Davenport Match Rules: 20 shots with 10 on Man and 10 on Sm. Ring Davenport. Time includes sighters. Lowest 10 shots **on Paper** count for record. Targets score to lead edge. Man target 0-20 points, 200 possible, Davenport Small ring 0-25, possible 250.

Main events except Davenport Match: 10 shots per target, lowest 10 count for record. Any Shots on paper, but outside of scoring rings count as 10. Bench match times include sighter time. Offhand match times include a 10 minute sight in time before record shots are fired. **Range officer will ask and check for shots on record targets at the end of 10 minute period.**

Fun Side Match: to be announced at match

Match Awards: awards will be awarded for 1st-3rd for each main event, plus 1st-3rd Bench Aggregate, 1st-3rd Offhand Aggregate, 1st-3rd Grand Aggregate, 1st Traditional Grand Aggregate (2nd if 5 or more traditional shooters), Rimfire King, CF Iron Offhand King, CF Any sight Offhand King.

All other prizes will be door prizes awarded by drawing.

All matches will follow the ISSA rules as posted on the ISSA web site <http://www.issa-schuetzen.org/>. To obtain the latest version, download PDF file from the ISSA web site at the Rules link.

No Alcoholic Beverage to be consumed before shooting or during match time.

Housing: there is limited parking for RVs at the range minimal electrical hook ups. Also room for tent camping. Cots and/or sleeping bags are welcome. Club house has modern bathrooms and showers available.

Closest motels are available in LeClaire Ia. (3) 11 miles or Eldridge, Ia (1) 13 miles. Modern Camp grounds are possibly available at Scott County Park approx 9 miles.
